



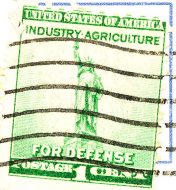

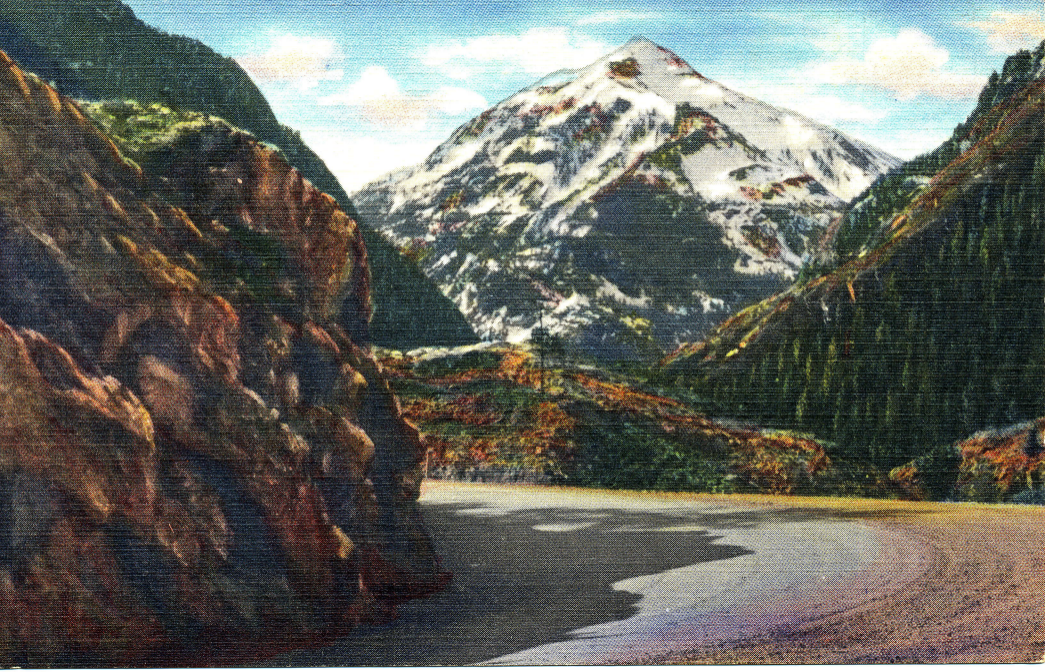

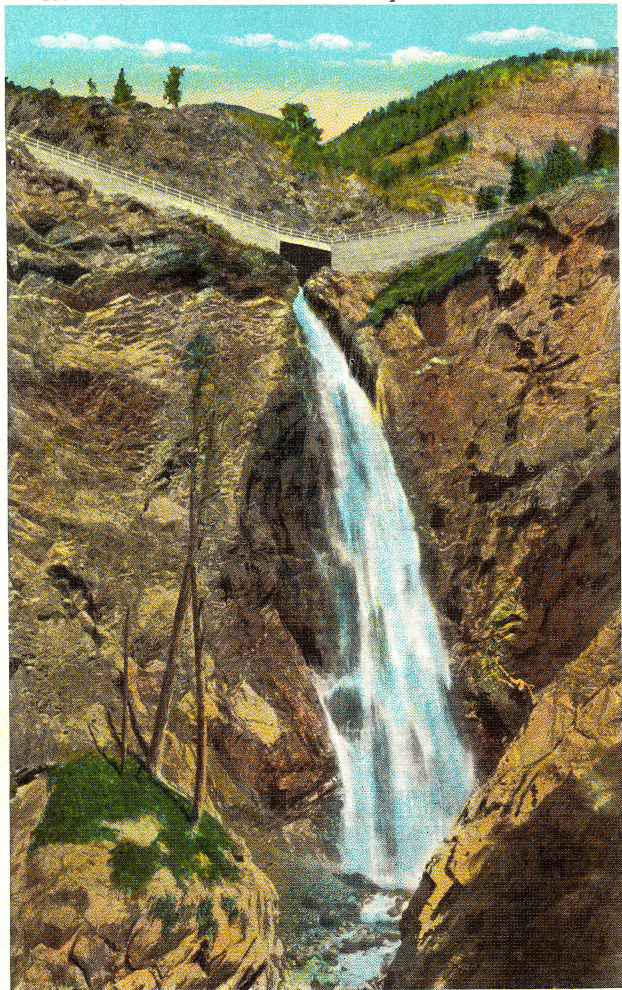

ton plunge over the edge of the Million Dollar High-
way to drop 227 feet to the depths of the Uncom-

BOX CANON is reached by a very short climb up the cliffs that encircle Ouray. For ages water has been wearing a great narrow chasm inside more than 300 feet deep which is filled with the roar and spray of the plunging waters.
