DIVORCE JUDGMENT

On this 6th day of January, 1966, came on the above entitled and numbered cause to be heard wherein BARBARA B. CHAMBERLAIN is plaintiff and THOMAS T. CHAMBERLAIN is defendant. The plaintiff appeared in person and by her attorney and announced ready for trial; the defendant, having filed an answer in this cause, appeared by his attorney of record. No jury being demanded, the matters of fact, as well as law, were submitted to and were determined by the Court. The Court, having heard the pleadings, the evidence and argument of counsel, is of the opinion that the material allegations in plaintiff's petition are supported by the evidence and are true; that all prerequisites of law have been complied with and that the plaintiff is entitled to judgment.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED by the Court that the bonds of matrimony heretofore existing between the plaintiff, BARBARA B. CHAMBERLAIN, and the defendant, THOMAS T. CHAMBERLAIN, be and the same are hereby annulled and dissolved and that the said plaintiff be and is hereby divorced from the said defendant.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that there are no children under eighteen years of this marriage and that there will be no children.

THE COURT FURTHER FINDS that the parties have entered into a Property Settlement Agreement which Property Settlement Agreement has been duly filed in this cause; that same appears to be a fair and equitable Property Settlement Agreement.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED that the Property Settlement Agreement filed herein is in all things approved and both parties are directed to execute any and all necessary legal instruments to carry out
